

# SPRING-FALL CAMPING

(cold/warm/hot weather)

## CLOTHING

- Waterproof hiking boots
  - Extra sneakers or shoes
  - Short-sleeved shirt
  - Shorts
  - Class A uniform (Boy Scout uniform shirt/shorts or pants/belt/socks) – required when traveling to and from camping location
  - Class B uniform (Troop 323 or other Scout T-shirt)
  - Clothes for sleeping
  - Long thermal underwear or Under Armour (shirts and pants) – 2 pair (1 for day and 1 for night)
  - Swim trunks if swimming is planned for trip
- Daily change of clothes (for 2 days):
- Long-sleeved shirts
  - Blue jeans or other long pants
  - Socks (twice as many if wet weather, wool for colder conditions)
  - Underwear

## OUTERWEAR

- Jacket (winter coat if colder forecast)
- Cloth stocking cap
- Gloves or mittens
- Hooded sweatshirt
- Poncho or raincoat

## PERSONAL ITEMS

- Pocket knife – *NO sheath knives*
- Totin' Chip card
- Hand soap in container
- Washcloth
- Towel
- Shampoo (if showers available)
- Toothbrush
- Toothpaste
- Deodorant (*NON-AEROSOL*)
- Comb and/or brush

## BEDDING

- Tent – 1 per 2-3 Scouts
- Plastic ground cloth for under tent
- Winter weight sleeping bag (20 degree or less)
- Sleeping bag liner and/or blanket(s) as dictated by forecast
- Sleeping pad

## CAMPING GEAR

- Headlamp/Flashlight with extra batteries and extra bulb
- Mess kit (plate, bowl, and cup)
- Utensil kit (knife, fork, and spoon)
- Canteen or water bottle (with water)
- Laundry bag
- Garbage bag
- Boy Scout Handbook*
- Notebook and pencils or pens
- Backpack or duffel bag to carry everything in
- Daypack for any day hikes

## OPTIONAL ITEMS (you may be glad you brought)

- Hammock (if forecast permits)
- Hand warmer packets
- Pillow or air pillow
- Personal First Aid Kit
- Compass
- Sunscreen depending on forecast
- Lip balm
- Insect repellent (*NON-AEROSOL*) in warmer weather
- Folding camp chair
- Wooden matches in waterproof container
- Fire starters
- Nylon cord for clothesline
- Clothespins
- Toilet paper
- Digital camera
- Fishing equipment
- Playing cards, chess set
- Frisbee, football, etc.
- Hat or cap
- Shower footwear (if showers available)
- Sunglasses
- Watch
- Any prescription medications (given to Troop leaders)
- Spending money as indicated by adult leaders
